CITY & COUNTY CREDIT UNION WELCOMES NEW SCHOOL YEAR WITH SUCCESSFUL SUPPLY DRIVE

St. Paul, MN (September 14, 2015) – City & County Credit Union ushered in the new school year with a Back to School Supply Drive for Merrick Community Services. For two weeks, members and staff joined together and collected 1,573 back to school items, including 147 notebooks, 522 pencils and 116 glue sticks.

Supplies collected during the supply drive were used during Merrick Community Services' Back to School Bash. During the Bash, school-aged kids living in the East Metro received a free backpack filled with school supplies while parents visited resource tables focusing on health and school readiness.
